

HOW DO I PAY IN MY FUNDRAISING?

There are several ways you can pay in your fundraising. The easiest way is to make a donation online to your fundraising page using a credit or debit card. You can also make a direct bank transfer. Or you can send a cheque to us at Muddy Puddle Walk, Save the Children, 33 Lincoln Square South, Carlton VIC 3053. Remember to write your postcode, group name and reference number on the back of all cheques.

Please don't send cash in the post and remember to be eligible for the prizes all donations must be made on your fundraising page by 2nd September.

HOW DO I SET UP AN ONLINE FUNDRAISING PAGE?

Yes! Set up your online fundraising page at muddypuddlewalk.com.au. Remember to choose if you are a family, kindergarten, daycare, pre-school and tell us how many children will be participating so we can send you the most relevant goodies!

WHAT WILL I GET IN MY FUNDRAISING PACK?

Your Muddy Puddle Fundraising Pack will be sent out from June.

The pack is full of ideas to help busy grown-ups plan a great walk, including activities, fundraising tips to help you top up your total, and stories to help your little ones learn about the lives of other children around the world.

You'll also get advice from Peppa and her friends to help you decide which walk's right for you, planning tips and posters, stickers and muddy puddles to decorate.

HOW CAN WE RAISE MONEY?

There are lots of easy ways to raise money on your Muddy Puddle Walk. And however you fundraise, you'll help Save the Children make life better for children around the world.

Your Muddy Puddle Fundraising Pack is full of great ideas to raise money – so you can choose which option will work best for you and your children. You could ask for a donation from parents at your childcare or early learning provider, or hand out sponsorship forms to everyone who takes part.

Or, why not hold a Muddy Puddle Pie sale at your childcare or early childhood provider or home and ask for donations from everybody who buys a tasty treat? The extra money you raise could mean Save the Children can help get food to children who have to go to bed hungry every night.

You can be as creative as you like – ask for donations per puddle, or come up with your own challenge for your little ones. And don't forget to get your fellow teachers involved as well!

WHAT IF WE CAN'T GO OUTSIDE?

That's okay! You can still get involved and help children around the world. Set up a treasure hunt or an obstacle course inside and make your own muddy puddles using the puddle templates in your Fundraising Pack. Or if you can't get to your local park, why not go for a walk in the playground and make puddles out of mud and water — or even paint?



HOW LONG SHOULD MY WALK BE?

We suggest 800m for older children but your walk can be as short or as long as you like. Just make sure you choose a route that's safe and suitable for your children's capabilities. You will receive tips for planning a great walk in your Fundraising Pack.

As part of Save the Children International, Save the Children Australia works in more than 125 countries around the world.
