


## Z FOR ZANTO PRINTABLE MASKS



### Print and colour in the masks below!

#### SUPPLIES NEEDED

- A4 paper or card
- Crayons, paint or markers
- Scissors
- String (preferably elastic)
- Hole punch
- Sticky tape
- Paddlepop stick (optional)



#### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Print a mask on A4 paper or card
2. Colour in or paint your mask – your imagination is the only limit!
3. Cut out the mask and eye holes – get an adult to help with the small tricky spaces.
4. Strengthen the holes near the ears by placing sticky tape over them and folding them over the back of the mask. This will make your mask last longer.
5. Punch holes in the circles.
6. Cut a length of string. Tie the ends of the string on each hole. Try on the mask. If it's too tight or too loose adjust the length of the string.

**Option:** If you don't want to tie to mask on, you can make a handle and hold the mask in front of your face instead. Glue or tape a paddlepop stick or a pencil to the back of the mask.


#### COSTUME IDEAS
