## HIGHLIGHTS FROM 2016



**129 emergency responses** in 60 countries around the world.



**25,315 Aussie children and adults** directly reached through our education, health and protection projects.



**28,501 people in Fiji** were reached during Cyclone Winston, including 19,725 children from 109 primary and secondary schools and 52 Early Childhood Education centres.



**3,440 people in Dhaka, Bangladesh** have an increased ability to manage the impacts of climate change.




