17,000 children got the chance to learn – and play – through our education projects in Australia.

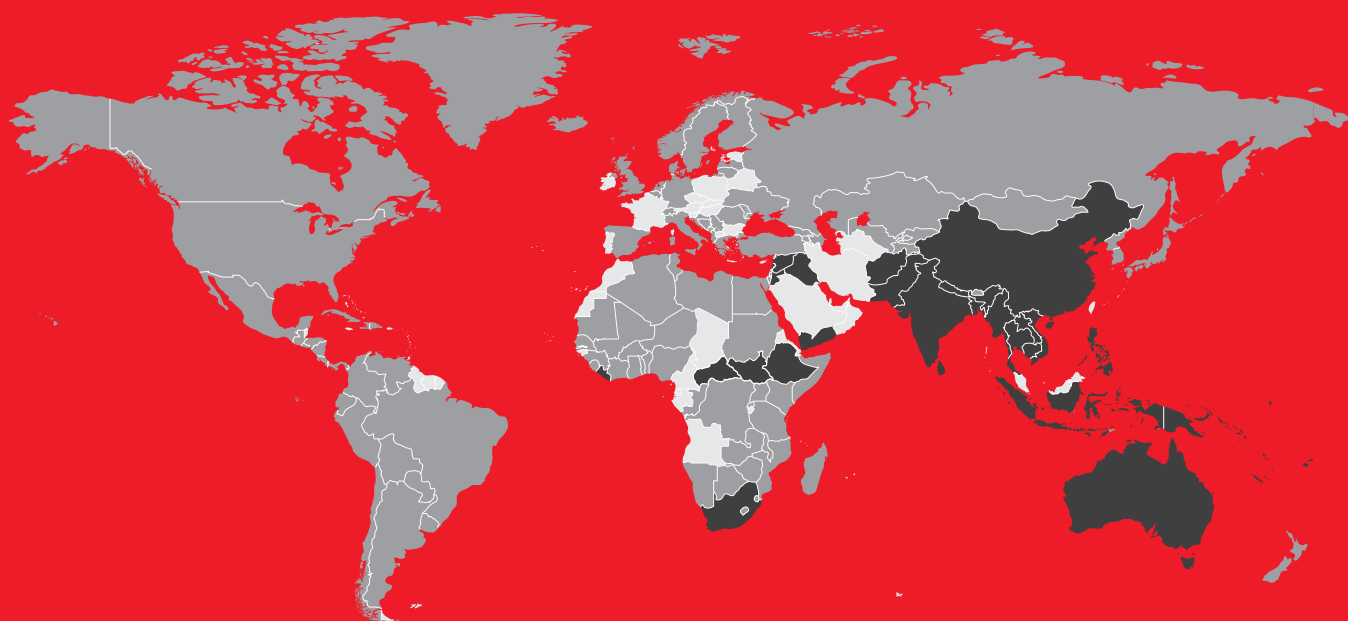


1,100 refugees and people seeking asylum in Nauru received critical support through our education, recreation and welfare project.

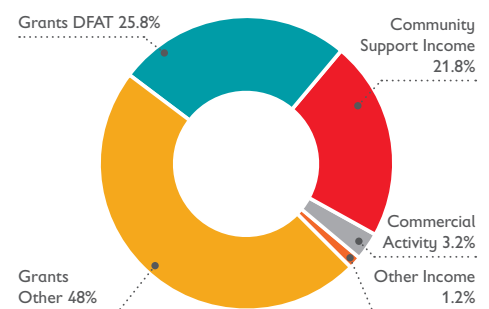

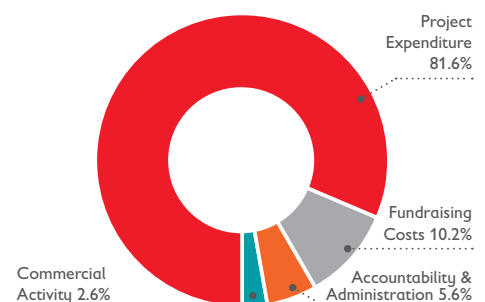
